

Air Compressor Maintenance Log

Record the tank drain that protects against internal corrosion, and keep the servicing history for a machine that holds pressure.

Service and tank drain record for an air compressor. Draining condensate is the one job that decides whether the tank stays safe.

DRAIN IT EVERY TIME

Drain the tank after every session. Water collects in the bottom and corrodes the tank from the inside, where you cannot see it. Record it here so you know it is actually being done.
