

Equine Dental Record

Keep a dental history so that changes in a horse's mouth are tracked rather than rediscovered every couple of years.

Dental visits, what was found and what was done — with the date the practitioner wants to see the horse again.

WHO MAY DO WHAT DIFFERS BY COUNTRY

Who may perform equine dentistry, and what procedures require a vet, differ by country and are regulated in many. No interval is printed: it depends on the horse's age, teeth and work. Record who did it and what qualification they hold.
