

Exotic Pet Handover Sheet

Give a sitter the numbers and the failure procedures, so they are not guessing about a species they have never kept.

What a sitter must know, per animal, written for somebody who has never kept this species.

ASSUME THE SITTER KNOWS NOTHING ABOUT THIS SPECIES
Exotic species are unforgiving of a well-meaning sitter guessing. Write the numbers down — your numbers, from your own husbandry sheet — along with what to do if a thermostat fails and who to ring. Do not assume anything is obvious.
