

Keep the visitor record that matters when disease is traced, and make the boot dip a thing that is recorded rather than assumed.

Who came onto the holding, where they had been, and what they did before they walked on your ground.

Disease arrives on boots, wheels and second-hand equipment. A visitor log is the record that matters when something is traced. No disinfectant, dilution or contact time is recommended here — those are on the product label and, for notifiable disease, set by your authority.
