

First Aid Kit Contents and Expiry Check

Check a kit against the contents list that applies to it and leave a dated record of what was missing, what had expired and what was put back.

One kit, one check: what should be in it, what is actually in it, what expires first and what was put back. Print one per kit and keep the run of them together.

No contents list and no check interval are printed on this sheet, and that is deliberate. What a kit is expected to hold, and how often it is looked at, differ by country and by whether the kit belongs to a house, a vehicle or a workplace — and they change. Check what applies to yours, then write your own required quantity against each item. This sheet records what you found; it does not tell you what to hold.
