

Fruit Tree and Pruning Record

Keep the details that vanish with the label — variety, rootstock and planting year — and build a pruning and cropping history alongside them.

A register of the fruit trees and bushes on the place — variety, rootstock and planting date — with a running record of pruning, feeding, yield and problems over the page.

WHAT YOU DID, NOT WHAT TO DO

When and how a tree is pruned depends on the fruit, the rootstock, the trained form and the climate, so no schedule is printed here. Take the method from guidance for your species and your area; this sheet records what you did, when, and what happened afterwards — which is the part nobody remembers three winters later.
