

See what a vehicle actually costs to run and spot a change in fuel consumption early, which is often the first sign that something mechanical is wrong.

Every fill on one line with the odometer beside it, so distance and consumption can be worked out from the sheet itself. A change in consumption is often the first sign of a mechanical problem.

No units are printed anywhere on this sheet, and no consumption figures either. Write at the top which units the odometer reads in, which you buy fuel in, and how you want consumption expressed — then keep to them, because a column of numbers in mixed units records nothing. Fill to the same point every time and read the odometer at the pump: brim to brim is what makes one line comparable with the next.
