

# Harness and Fall Arrest Inspection Record

Tie an inspection record to a specific piece of equipment by serial number, and record what was found and what was done about it.

Pre-use and periodic checks for harnesses, lanyards and anchor lines, with the serial numbers that tie a record to a piece of kit.

## THE MANUFACTURER AND YOUR RULES SET THE CRITERIA

No pass or fail criteria, no inspection intervals and no service life are printed on this sheet. They are set by the manufacturer and by the law where you are working, they differ between products, and detailed inspection usually has to be done by a competent person. Check what applies and record the result here.

## HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Record the serial number and date of manufacture from the label. Without them, an inspection record belongs to no particular harness.
- 2 Anything failed goes out of service immediately and is quarantined, not left in the van.
- 3 Record who inspected it and what makes them competent to.
