

Horse Care Schedule and Due-Date Chart

Keep four kinds of routine care running on four different intervals visible on one page, so the next due date is read rather than guessed.

Four kinds of routine care running on four different intervals, on one page. Each line says what was done, when, how often it comes round and the date it next falls due.

THEIR INTERVAL, NOT OURS

No intervals are printed here, and no treatments. How often any of this is done depends on the horse, the yard, the season and the region, and what has to be recorded — and by whom — differs by country. The interval column holds the one your farrier, vet, dentist or yard actually gave you; write beside it who told you.
