

Horse Information and Passport Summary

Give whoever is standing in for you one page with everything they need, on the stable door rather than in a folder at home.

The one page somebody standing in for you needs — identity, vet, farrier, insurance, and what this horse does and does not do.

KEEP IT WHERE THE HORSE IS
Keep this where the horse is, not at home. In an emergency the useful sheet is the one on the stable door. Consider what a stranger reading it would learn before including anything personal.
