

Horse Transport and Journey Record

Record journeys and the pre-loading checks, which is both good practice and, for longer or commercial journeys, often a requirement.

The journey — who travelled, how long, where you stopped, and how the horse was on arrival.

TRANSPORT RULES APPLY SOONER THAN PEOPLE EXPECT
Rules on transporting horses — journey times, documentation, authorisation and whether the journey counts as commercial — differ by country and can apply even to short trips to a competition. Check what applies before you load.

BEFORE LOADING

- ☐ Passport travelling with the horse
- ☐ Trailer or box floor and ramp checked
- ☐ Partitions and breast bars secure
- ☐ Tyres and pressures checked, including the spare
- ☐ Water, haynet and first aid kit aboard
- ☐ Breakdown cover valid for a vehicle carrying horses
