

Horse Vaccination Record

Keep a vaccination history with batch numbers, which is the record a competition venue, a livery yard or an insurer will ask to see.

Vaccinations given, by whom, with batch numbers — the record a competition venue or a livery yard will ask to see.

YOUR GOVERNING BODY SETS THE SCHEDULE

No vaccination schedule is printed. Requirements differ by country, by discipline and by governing body, and the rules for competition are strict about intervals and about how they are recorded — a day out can invalidate an entry. Your vet and your governing body set them; this records what happened.

HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Record the batch number from the vial. A passport entry without one is queried.
- 2 Note which vaccine and against what — combined vaccines vary.
- 3 Have the vet sign, and keep the passport entry as the primary record.
- 4 Diarise the next due date somewhere other than this sheet as well.
