

Horse Worming and Treatment Record

Record worming with the active ingredient written down, which is what makes a resistance-aware plan possible instead of dosing out of habit.

What was given, to which horse, and when — with the product and the reason, so a worming plan is possible rather than habitual.

RECORD THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT, NOT JUST THE BRAND

No wormer, dose or interval is printed here. Routine dosing without testing is now widely advised against because of resistance, and the right approach depends on your grazing, your worm counts and your vet. Record the product's active ingredient as well as its brand — rotation is managed by ingredient, not by name.
