

Livery Client Information Sheet

Take the information a yard needs at the point a horse arrives, rather than trying to find it during an emergency at eleven at night.

Everything the yard needs about one horse and one owner, taken at the start rather than asked for at the worst moment.

INFORMATION, NOT AN AGREEMENT

A livery agreement is a contract and this sheet is not one. It records the practical information a yard needs. What each party is liable for, notice periods and insurance requirements belong in a written agreement — take advice on that separately.
