

Pet Medication and Treatment Log

Record every dose as it is actually given, so that two people in the same house cannot both give the tablet or both assume the other did.

A running record of every dose actually given to an animal — date, medicine, amount, time and who gave it. Useful when more than one person is doing the giving, and useful to hand back to the vet.

COPY THE LABEL — THIS PAGE DECIDES NOTHING

This sheet records what was given. It does not tell you what to give. Copy the medicine, the amount and the timing straight from the label your vet dispensed, and if anything on that label is unclear, ring the practice rather than guessing. A medicine that is safe for one animal can be dangerous for another.
