

# Pig Farrowing and Litter Record

Keep each sow's breeding history on one page, so decisions about which sows to keep are made from records rather than impressions.

One line per farrowing — sow, boar, born alive, losses and what was weaned — so a sow's history is on paper rather than in somebody's memory.

## A RECORD OF THE FARROWING, NOT GUIDANCE ON IT

This records what happened. It sets no target litter size, no weaning age and no intervention point: those depend on your breed, your housing and your vet. Losses are recorded honestly here because a season read back without them teaches nothing.

### HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Fill it in at the pen, on the day. Timings and assistance are the details that blur first.
- 2 Record the sow's parity — it is what makes the numbers comparable.
- 3 Note anything you would do differently with this sow next time.
