

Planting and Sowing Schedule

Capture what you planned, what you actually did and what happened, which is the comparison that makes next season better and the one nobody writes down.

One line per crop: when you meant to sow it, when you actually did, what you harvested and what to change next year.

PLANNED AGAINST ACTUAL

No dates and no spacings are printed here. Sowing times depend on your climate and your last frost, and the packet is the better source. This sheet exists to capture what you decided and what then happened, which is the part nobody writes down.

HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Fill in the planned column in winter, when you have time to think about it.
- 2 Fill in the actual column on the day, even when it is weeks off the plan.
- 3 Method means direct, module or bought-in plant — whatever you did.
- 4 The result column is the whole point — next January it is the only honest record you have.
