

Puppy Vaccination and Worming Schedule

Keep the first year of a puppy's treatments in one place, with the dates your vet gave you written down before you forget them.

A first-year planner for a puppy: the vaccinations and the worming, flea and tick treatments, with the date each was actually given, the product used, the weight at the time and when the next one falls due.

YOUR VET SETS THE DATES, NOT THIS PAGE

There is no schedule printed on this sheet, and that is on purpose. Which treatments a puppy has, at what age, with what product and how far apart differs by country, by region and by the individual dog. Ask your vet for the plan at the first appointment, write their dates into the 'due' column, and fill the rest in as you go.
