HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Write the species and the source of your husbandry targets before anything else.
- 2 Measure with a probe or digital gauge at animal level, not with a dial stuck to the glass.
- 3 Record what you measured, including the readings you were not happy with.
- 4 Take the sheet to an exotics vet — a fortnight of readings is worth more than a description.
