

Seed Stock and Viability Record

Know what is already in the seed box, and whether it still comes up, before you spend January ordering another copy of it.

Everything in the seed box on one page — where it came from, how old it is, how much is left and whether it still germinates. Fill it in before you order, not after.

THE PACKET IS THE SOURCE

No sowing dates and no viability lifespans are printed on this sheet. How long seed stays worth sowing depends on the species and on how it has been stored, and the packet in your hand is the source for its own sow-by date. If you want a germination figure, count out a sample, count how many come up, and write both numbers down — that result is about your seed and your storage, which is what makes it worth having.
