

Senior Horse Care Record

Notice the slow changes in an older horse, which the person who sees it every day is always the last to spot.

The extra checks an older horse needs, recorded — weight, teeth, feet, coat and how well the winter is going.

SLOW CHANGES ARE THE ONES YOU MISS

Older horses change slowly, which is exactly why a written record beats an impression: the person who sees a horse every day is the last to notice. This prescribes nothing — what an individual older horse needs is for your vet.
