

Smoke and CO Alarm Test Log

Prove the alarms were tested, and catch the thing most people miss: alarms have an expiry date, and a working test button does not mean a working sensor.

A test record for every smoke and carbon monoxide alarm in the building — where each one is, when it was tested, and when the unit itself expires.

ALARMS EXPIRE

Alarms have an end-of-life date, usually printed on the back, and a working test button does not mean a working sensor. Write the replace-by date in the register below the first time you take each one down.
