

Stock Take Sheet

Count stock area by area and see the variance beside the count, so a stock take produces a number you can act on rather than a vague reassurance.

A counting sheet for a stock take — item, location, what the records say, what is actually on the shelf, and the difference between the two.

HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1 Count what is physically there first, then write the expected figure beside it.
- 2 One area per sheet, and number the sheets as you go.
- 3 Write the variance even when it is zero — a blank means nobody counted it.
