

# Sump Pump Test Log

Prove the pump still works before the water arrives, including the backup that nobody ever tests.

A test record for a sump pump. A pump that has not been tested since last winter is not a pump, it is a hope.

HOW TO USE THIS SHEET

- 1
- Pour a bucket of water into the pit until the float lifts. The pump should start, clear the pit and stop cleanly.
- 2
- Check the discharge actually runs outside and is not frozen, blocked or draining back.
- 3
- Test the backup pump and its battery separately — that is the one that matters.
